

The John R. Hamann Memorial Scholarship

Merit- based scholarship

- Purpose:** The John R. Hamann Memorial Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship awarded to a bachelor degree seeking student in Tribal Environmental Science or Criminal Justice.
- Criteria:** The candidates eligible for the scholarship must be a junior/senior enrolled in the United Tribes Technical College Tribal Environmental Science or Criminal Justice bachelor degree program. The applicant must hold a career GPA of 3.5 or higher. Consideration will be given to current academic achievement, community involvement, and leadership roles.
- Guidelines:** The John R. Hamann Memorial Scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in December at the end of the fall semester.
- Amount:** One (1) \$500 scholarship will be awarded during the academic year.
- Deadline:** The application deadline is October 16th. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. The United Tribes Technical College Scholarship panel uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
- Renewal Process:** The John R. Hamann Memorial Scholarship is not renewable. Previous scholarship recipients cannot re-apply.

Duration: Fall 2016 to Fall 2020 (five years)

Academic Year: One (1) award per academic year.

Amount: \$500

Use: To cover educational expenses that include: room/board, child care, textbooks, technology, and tuition.

Deadline: October 16th

Award: To be awarded at the end of the fall semester, to be applied to student's account for spring

Criteria: Bachelor degree seeking student in Tribal Environmental Science or Criminal Justice

Junior/Senior status

*Military background (not required, but recognized)

GPA – 3.5 +

Part-time/full time student

Native and Non-Native applicant

Campus/Online student

Two academic/character recommendation letters – must be from UTTC faculty or department chair.

Non-eligibility – transfer student who holds an AAS degree outside of Tribal Environmental Science or Criminal Justice

Applicant Essay Criteria:

- Academic achievement
- Community involvement/Leadership roles (current – within the last two years)
- Awards and recognitions (current – within the last two years)
- Work history/*military history
- Personal and/or family attributes

Selection Process:

Initial selections will be made by the UTTC Scholarship Selection panel members. *If an applicant is related to a member of the selection panel the Hamann family requests that the panel member removes themselves from the selection process.* The top three scholarship candidates' information will be then forwarded to the Hamann family for final selection. A member of the Hamann family will physically present the John R. Hamann Memorial Scholarship award to the selected candidate at a date and time determined by United Tribes Technical College.
